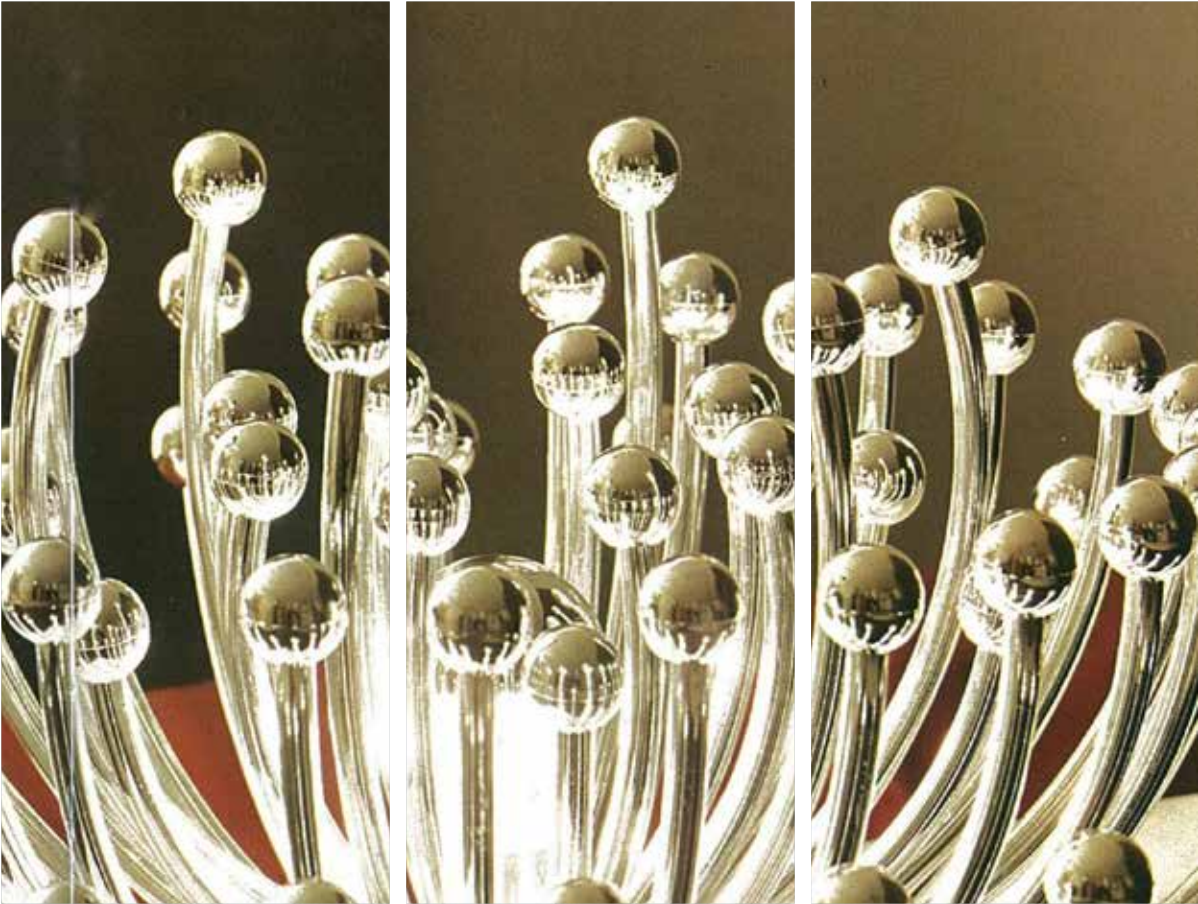

STUDIO TETRARCH

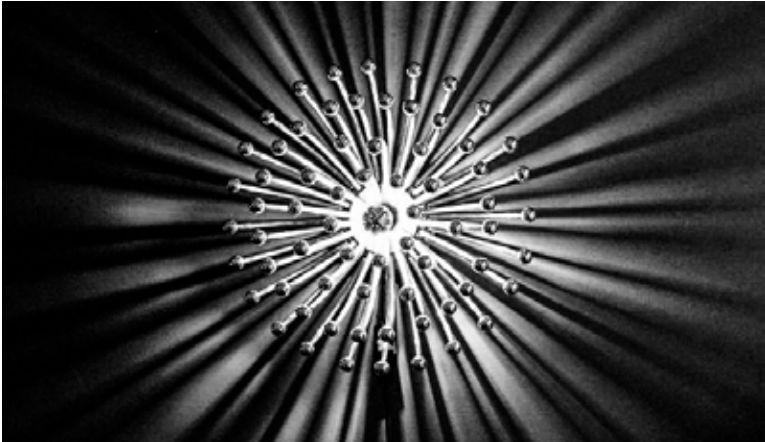

Studio Tetrarch was composed by four architects (Adelaide Bonati, Carla Fiederspiel, Silvio Bonatti and Enrico de Munari) and designed mostly lamps doing pieces that became rightfully Design's history. Pistillo lamp was designed in 1970. The study of nature inspired this project, especially the reproductive organ of a flower.



INSPIRATION

A unique centrepiece luminaire styled in accordance with the forms of the natural universe. The name Pistillo comes from the female reproductive organ of flowers. The attraction of the design and styling are particularly evident in the chrome plated body and the arms that embrace the central lamp. Designed by Studio Tetrarch in 1970, this luminaire has continued to exert its original appeal right through to the 21st century. Pistillo is a creatively styled and wholly contemporary luminaire that adapts perfectly to all types of settings.

Pistillo and Pistillino lamps and can be used in different environments. The two different sizes and product **multifunctionality** allow to create compositions and to customize your own project.

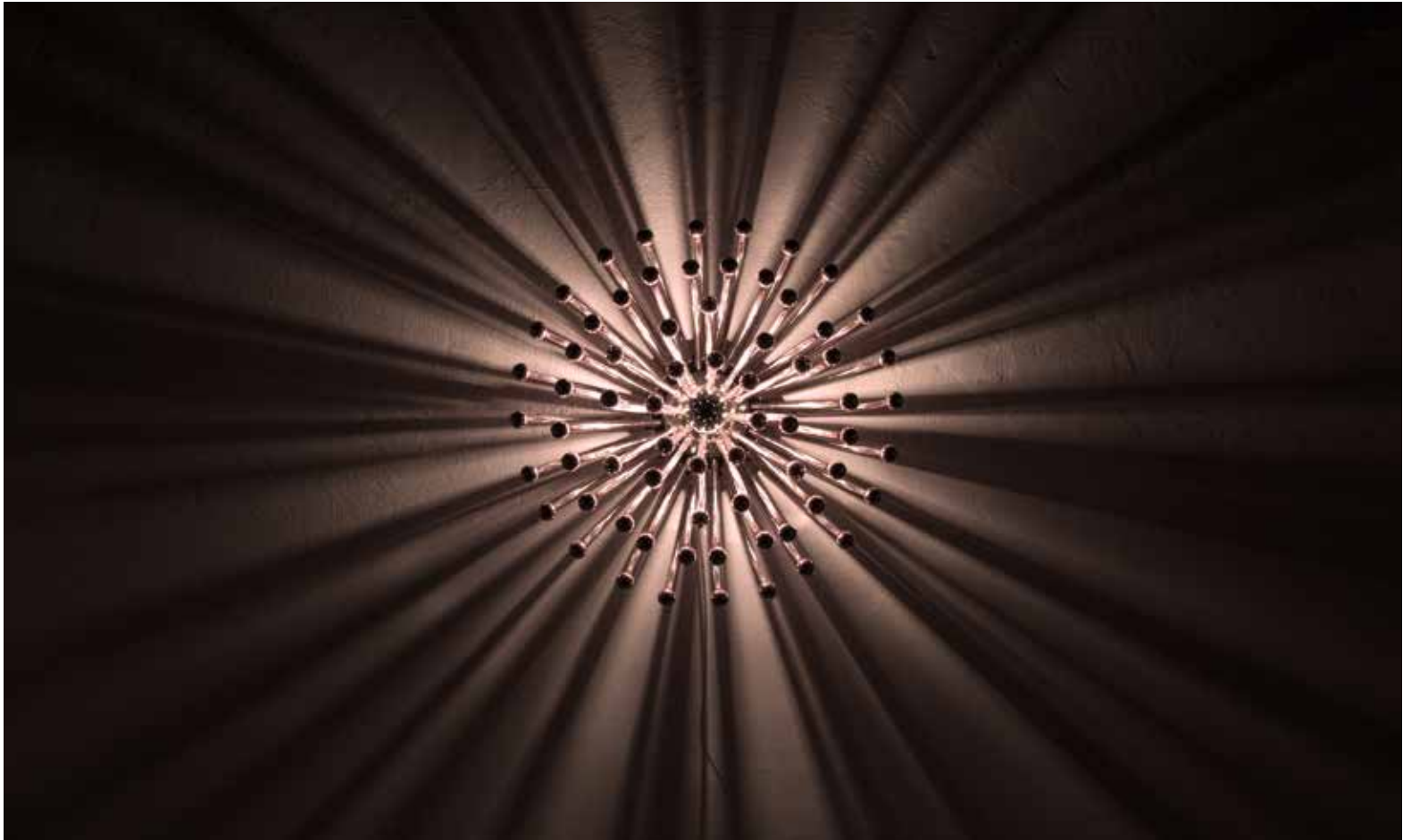

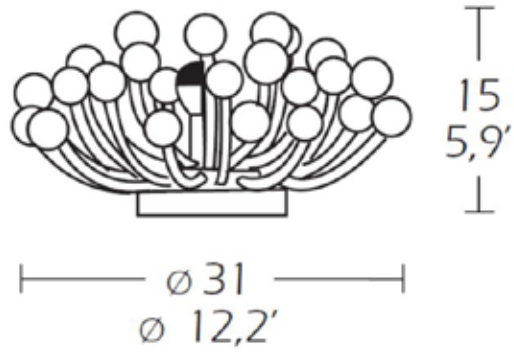

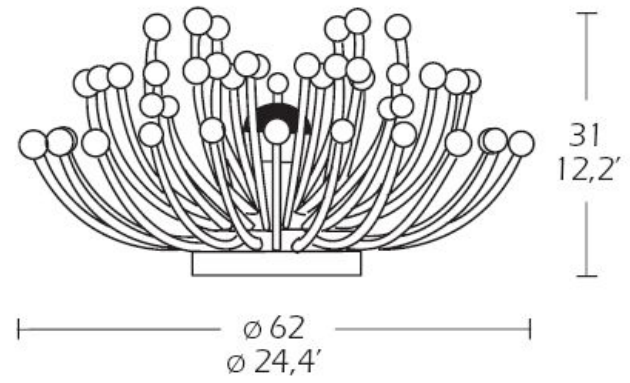
